**The A12 Trunk Road (Breydon Bridge, Great Yarmouth,
Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Pedestrians)
Order 2012**

Made - - - - *8th May 2012*

Coming into force - - *15th May 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road (“the A12”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Great Yarmouth in the County of Norfolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Breydon Bridge, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Pedestrians) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 15th May 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A12 at Great Yarmouth between its junctions with the A47 Acle New Road (Vauxhall) Roundabout and the A1243 Gapton Hall/Pasteur Road Roundabout;

“bicycle” means a pedal cycle with fewer than four wheels and not being a mechanically propelled vehicle;

“the first works” mean the installation of CCTV and new traffic barriers, pump repairs, and the replacement of elements to the existing crossing control system at Breydon Bridge;

“the second works” mean annual routine maintenance to Breydon Bridge;

“a first works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 21st May 2012 or on any subsequent day until the first works have been completed;

“a second works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 12th June 2012 or on any subsequent day until the second works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, during a first works period or a second works period, no –

- (a) person shall cause or permit any vehicle to, or
- (b) pedestrian, or person using a bicycle shall,

enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle -

- (a) being used for or in connection with the works or for traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform, or
- (d) proceeding to or from the Country Park or properties which are accessible from, and only from, the length of trunk road described at 2 above.

5. During a first works period or a second works period, the provisions of The A47 Trunk Road (Great Yarmouth Western Bypass) (Prohibition of Right Turns) Order 1988(a) are hereby suspended.
