**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Duxford)
(Amendment) Regulations 2012**

Made - - - - *10th May 2012*

Coming into force - - *27th May 2012*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Duxford, Cambridgeshire by reason of the holding of flying displays that are scheduled to take place on 27th May, 30th June, 1st July, 8th and 9th September and 14th October 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Duxford) (Amendment) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 27th May 2012.

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Duxford) Regulations 2012(b) are amended as follows.

3. For regulation 3(1), substitute the following—

“3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between—

- (a) 1100 hours and 1700 hours on 27th May 2012,
- (b) 1100 hours and 1700 hours on 30th June and 1st July 2012,
- (c) 1100 hours and 1700 hours on 8th and 9th September 2012, and
- (d) 1000 hours and 1700 hours on 14th October 2012,

no aircraft is to fly below 4,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 2.2 nautical miles whose centre is at 520539N 0000753E.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Duxford) Regulations 2012 (S.I. 2012/150) (“the principal Regulations”).

The effect of the amendment is to bring forward to 1000 hours the commencement time of the flying restrictions applicable on 14th October in relation to flying displays at Duxford under the principal Regulations.

Full details of the restricted airspace will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
