The London – Penzance Trunk Road (A38) (Dobwalls to Trerulefoot Roundabout) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Clearways) Order 1978 (Variation) Order 2009 (Revocation) Order 2012

Made - - - - 16 May 2012

Coming into force - - 28 May 2012

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 1(1) and 2(1) and 2(2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The London – Penzance Trunk Road (A38) (Dobwalls to Trerulefoot Roundabout) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Clearways) Order 1978 (Variation) Order 2009 (Revocation) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 28 May 2012.

2. The London – Penzance Trunk Road (A38) (Dobwalls to Trerulefoot Roundabout) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Clearways) Order 1978 (Variation) Order 2009 (b) is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This does not form part of the Order)

The London – Penzance Trunk Road (A38) (Dobwalls to Trerulefoot Roundabout) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Clearways) Order 1978 (Variation) Order 2009 included a length of carriageway that had been de-trunked. The Secretary of State has no authority over de-trunked carriageways. It was decided that the Order should be revoked and then remade without reference to the length of de-trunked carriageway.
