**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Duxford)
Regulations 2012**

Made - - - - - *20th January 2012*

Coming into force - - - - - *27th May 2012*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Duxford, Cambridgeshire by reason of the holding of flying displays that are scheduled to take place on 27th May, 30th June and 1st July, 8th and 9th September and 14th October 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Duxford) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 27th May 2012.

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 1100 hours and 1700 hours on—

- (a) 27th May 2012,
- (b) 30th June and 1st July 2012,
- (c) 8th and 9th September 2012, and
- (d) 14th October 2012,

no aircraft is to fly below 4,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 2.2 nautical miles whose centre is at 520539N 0000753E.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the permission of the flying display director at Duxford Aerodrome.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Duxford, Cambridgeshire, during flying displays that are scheduled to be held there during 2012.

This event will be open to the general public, and a large number of aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the air show. The Civil Aviation Authority and Department for Transport consider that during the displays, flying should be restricted in the vicinity of Duxford Aerodrome for reasons of public safety.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
