ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 58, Burtree) (Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012

Made - - - - - *31st May 2012*
Coming into force - - - - - *10th June 2012*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway and connecting roads, in the District of Darlington, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads should be restricted because local authority carriageway resurfacing works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 58, Burtree) (Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 10th June 2012.
2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 11th June 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the:
 - (i) A1(M) Motorway northbound or southbound exit slip roads at Junction 58 (Burtree); or
 - (ii) circulatory carriageway of the A68 Trunk Road, Burtree Interchange.
3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
