ROAD TRAFFIC

The M180 Motorway (Junction 4 to Junction 5) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012

Made - - - - *7th June 2012*

Coming into force - *17th June 2012*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M180 Motorway and connecting roads, in the County of North Lincolnshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway should be restricted because safety barrier installation and renewal works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M180 Motorway (Junction 4 to Junction 5) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 17th June 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 18th June 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the M180 Motorway:

- (i) eastbound carriageway from a point 1814 metres east of the nose of the eastbound entry slip road at Junction 4 (Broughton) eastwards for a distance of 3490 metres; or
- (ii) westbound carriageway from a point 335 metres west of the nose of the westbound entry slip road at Junction 5 (Barnetby) westwards for a distance of 3490 metres.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.

4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
