**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A458 Trunk Road (Cardeston to Colcott, Shropshire)  
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *1st June 2012*

*Coming into force* - - *8th June 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A458 Trunk Road (“the A458”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road between Cardeston and Colcott in the County of Shropshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A458 Trunk Road (Cardeston to Colcott, Shropshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 8th June 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A458 –  
(a) between its roundabout junction with the A5 at Colcott and its junction with But Lane; and  
(b) between its junction with the B4393 Alberbury Road and its junction with Rowton Avenue at Cardeston;

"the works period" means the period starting at 09:30 hours on Monday 11th June 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of -

- (a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, and
- (b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and
- (c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
