ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road (Warwick Bypass) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - *28th May 2012*

Coming into force - - *4th June 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads, near Leek Wooton in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Warwick Bypass) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 4th June 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this order, no person shall, during the period starting at 08:30 hours on Sunday 10th June 2012 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this order, drive any motor vehicle on the slip road –

- (i) leading from the northbound carriageway of the A46 to its roundabout junction with the B4115/Warwick Road;
- (ii) leading from the southbound carriageway of the A46 to its roundabout junction with the B4115/Warwick Road.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
