**The M11 Motorway (Junction 13) Northbound Exit Slip Road
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

<i>Made</i>	- - - -	<i>18th June 2012</i>
<i>Coming into force</i>	- -	<i>25th June 2012</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M11 Motorway (“the M11”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M11 Motorway (Junction 13) Northbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 25th June 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 2nd July 2012, or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or a Sunday) until drainage, resurfacing, road marking, installation of Motorway Incident Detection (MIDAS) loops and grass cutting works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the M11 northbound exit slip road at Junction 13.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance and traffic officer purposes.
