ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway (Junction 25, Northbound Exit and Southbound Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - -

18th June 2012

Coming into force - -

8th July 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those slip roads in the District of Wigan in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junction 25, Northbound Exit and Southbound Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 8th July 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M6 Motorway;

“works” means concrete repairs and maintenance works;

“the works period” means ten nights between 2200 hours and 0600 hours (finishing at 0500 hours on weekday mornings) starting on Monday 9 July 2012 and ending on Saturday 28 July 2012.

However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the first slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 25;

“the second slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 25.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first and second slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
