**The M53 Motorway (Junction 9, Northbound and Southbound
Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2012**

Made - - - - *3rd July 2012*
Coming into force - - *8th July 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M53 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those slip roads in Cheshire West and Chester should be prohibited because works are proposed on the M53 Junction 9 roundabout:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M53 Motorway (Junction 9, Northbound and Southbound Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 8th July 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M53 Motorway;

“works” means resurfacing works on the M53 Junction 9 roundabout;

“the works period” means four nights between 2200 hours and 0600 hours starting on Monday 9 July 2012 and ending on Friday 13 July 2012. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the first slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 9;

“the second slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 9;

“the third slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 9;

“the fourth slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 9;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first, second, third and fourth slip roads.
4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
