ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A46 Trunk Road (Stratford-upon-Avon, Warwickshire)
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 25th June 2012

Coming into force - - 2nd July 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road west of Stratford upon Avon in the County of Warwickshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Stratford-upon-Avon, Warwickshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 2nd July 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A46 from its roundabout junction with the A422 (Shottery Roundabout) to its junction with Drayton Manor Drive;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 9th July 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on lengths of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths of road are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the footway adjacent to northbound carriageway of the trunk road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

(a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;

(b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;

(c) article 4 shall not apply to –

- (i) any pedestrian engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activities;
- (ii) any pedestrian acting under the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (iii) personnel engaged in the said works; or
- (iv) any pedestrian proceeding in the footway to or from premises which are accessible for that pedestrian from, and only from, that footway.
