ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5111 and A52 Trunk Roads (Derby) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - -10th July 2012

Coming into force - -17th July 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5111 Trunk road (“the A5111”) and A52 Trunk Road (“the A52”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of the A5111 and on one of those connecting roads in the City of Derby should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5111 and A52 Trunk Roads (Derby) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 17th July 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the link road” means the link road leading from the westbound carriageway of the A52 to the southbound carriageway of the A5111 Raynesway; and

“the works period” means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Tuesday 24th July 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the southbound carriageway of the A5111 at its junctions with the slip roads leading to and from the roundabout junction with the E Service Road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
