**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Eastbourne)
Regulations 2012**

Made - - - - - *26th January 2012*

Coming into force - - - - - *9th August 2012*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Eastbourne, East Sussex, by reason of the intended holding of a flying display that is scheduled to take place between 9th and 12th August 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009^(a).

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Eastbourne) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 9th August 2012.

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) and during the periods specified in paragraph (3) no aircraft is to fly below 5,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by straight lines joining successively the following points—

- (a) 504047N 0001603E,
- (b) 504619N 0002508E,
- (c) 505038N 0001835E,
- (d) 504506N 0000930E, and
- (e) 504047N 0001603E.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the permission of the Eastbourne Airshow flying display director.

(3) The periods referred to in paragraph (1) are—

- (a) between 1100 hours and 1600 hours on 9th August 2012,
- (b) between 1100 hours and 2000 hours on 10th August 2012,
- (c) between 1200 hours and 1700 hours on 11th August 2012, and
- (d) between 1100 hours and 1700 hours on 12th August 2012.

(a) S.I. 2009/3015, to which there are amendments that are not relevant to these Regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Eastbourne, East Sussex, on the occasion of an Air Show that will be held along the seafront and over the sea at Eastbourne during the period from 9th to 12th August 2012. A large number of civil and military aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the event. The Civil Aviation Authority considers that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of Eastbourne on the display days for reasons of public safety and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

Full details of the restricted airspace will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM. In relation to the permission mentioned in regulation 3(2), the Eastbourne Airshow flying display director may be contacted on telephone 07711 437499.
