ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A30 Trunk Road (Bodmin Bypass) (Temporary Restriction
of Traffic) Order 2012**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	<i>1st August 2012</i>
<i>Coming into force</i> - -	<i>4th August 2012</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road (“the A30”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road near Bodmin in Cornwall should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Bodmin Bypass) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 4th August 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the first length of the A30” means the westbound carriageway of the A30 near Bodmin from a point 2000 metres east of the centre of Higher Tredenham Bridge to a point 500 metres west of the centre of that bridge;

“the second length of the A30” means the westbound carriageway of the A30 near Bodmin from a point 800 metres east of the centre of Higher Tredenham Bridge to a point 500 metres west of the centre of that bridge;

“the works” mean resurfacing and maintenance works;

“a works period” means a period of 11 hours starting at 19.00 hours on Monday 6th August 2012 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of the A30.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the second length of the A30 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1;

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

6. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
