**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A45 Trunk Road (Ryton-on-Dunsmore, Warwickshire)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - 15th August 2012

*Coming into force* - - 22nd August 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Ryton-on-Dunsmore in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Ryton-on-Dunsmore, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 22nd August 2012.

2. In this Order:

“layby”

means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“bus stop area”

means any area of a carriageway on a side of the trunk road, intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1025,

1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a);

“the works period”

means the period starting at 09:00 hours on Wednesday 29th August 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A45 from its roundabout junction with the A445 and Wolston Lane to its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A423 Oxford Road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any bus stop area situated adjacent to the length of trunk road described in 3 above.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle –
- i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
  - iii) being used in connection with the said works.
