**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A45 Trunk Road (Tollbar End to Ryton-on-Dunsmore,  
Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made - - - - 23rd January 2012*

*Coming into force - - 30th January 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between Tollbar End and Ryton-on-Dunsmore, and three of those connecting roads, in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Tollbar End to Ryton-on-Dunsmore, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 30th January 2012.

2. In this Order:

| “Tollbar End Roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A45 at its roundabout junction with the A46 and the B4110;  |
| “Ryton Roundabout”       | means the circulatory carriageway of the A45 at its roundabout junction with the A445 and Wolston Lane, east of Ryton-on-Dunsmore;   |
| “the trunk road”         | means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A45 between Tollbar End Roundabout and Ryton Roundabout;   |
| “a slip road”            | means the slip road leading – <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>from the eastbound carriageway of the A45 to its roundabout junction with the A423;</li><li>from the westbound carriageway of the A45 to its roundabout junction with the A423; and</li><li>to the westbound carriageway of the A45 from its roundabout with the A423;</li></ol> |

“layby”	means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;
“the central reservation”	means that part of the trunk road which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using that road;
“the works period”	means the period starting at 21.00 hours on Sunday 5th February 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby adjacent to the trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through any gap in the central reservation of the trunk road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of –

- (a) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle-
  - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
  - (iii) being used in connection with the said works; and
- (b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
