**The A259 Trunk Road (Bexhill) (50 Miles Per Hour Speed
Limit) Order 2012**

Made - - - - - *3rd September 2012*

Coming into force - - - *14th September 2012*

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a), makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Bexhill) (50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 14th September 2012.

2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of the A259 Trunk Road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

THE SCHEDULE

Length of the Trunk Road subject to a speed limit of 50 miles per hour

Both carriageways of the A259 Trunk Road (Barnhorn Road) near Bexhill between points 103 metres west and 761 metres west of Coneyburrow Lane, a total distance of approximately 658 metres.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order imposes a 50mph speed limit on a length of the A259 Trunk Road near Bexhill as described in the Schedule and supersedes a temporary Order to this effect.
