**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A19 Trunk Road (Great North Run) (Temporary Prohibition  
of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *6th September 2012*

*Coming into force* - - *15th September 2012*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A19 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of South Tyneside, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads should be prohibited for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A19 Trunk Road (Great North Run) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 15th September 2012.
2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during the period starting at 09:00 hours on Sunday 16th September 2012 and continuing as necessary to facilitate the holding of the Great North Run, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A19 Trunk Road northbound or southbound exit slip roads at the A194 Lindisfarne Interchange.
3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes; or
  - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
