**The A20 Trunk Road (Townwall Street, Gap Closure)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

<i>Made</i>	- - - -	<i>1st October 2012</i>
<i>Coming into force</i>	- -	<i>20th October 2012</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A20 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A20 Trunk Road (Townwall Street, Gap Closure) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 20th October 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A20 Trunk Road (Townwall Street) in Dover in the County of Kent;

“central reservation” means that part of the trunk road which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using that road;

“the gap in the central reservation” means the gap in the central reservation of the trunk road opposite its junction with Woolcomber Street;

“works” mean replacing the signal controller and all associated works on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 22nd October 2012 or on any subsequent day until 19th April 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the gap in the central reservation.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

(d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
