

Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(a); and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"tip of the nosing" means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a trunk road or the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean resurfacing and other maintenance works;

"a works period" means a period of 11 hours starting at 19.00 hours on Friday 26th October 2012 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4, 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period:

- (a) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the first length of the A38 and the slip road;
- (b) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the second length of the A38 and the slip road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that road are displayed;
- (c) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads;
- (d) cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or remain in the layby adjacent to the eastbound carriageway of the A38 situated 300 metres east of the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at the Lee Mill Junction.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

5. The provisions of articles 3(c) and (d) shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes.

6. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
