ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A27 Trunk Road (Langstone Interchange, Slip Roads)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *22nd October 2012*

Coming into force - - *15th November 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Langstone Interchange, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 15th November 2012 and shall apply for a period of twelve months.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road near Havant in the County of Hampshire;

“a slip road” means –

- (i) any road leading to or from the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road at Langstone Interchange (A3023), or
- (ii) any road leading to or from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road at Langstone Interchange (A3023);

“works” mean bridge, road, street lighting, safety fence, cyclic maintenance, gantry and all associated work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Thursday 15th November 2012 or on any subsequent day until Thursday 14th November 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or

(d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
