ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5006 Trunk Road (Stoke on Trent, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 22nd October 2012

Coming into force - - 29th October 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5006 Trunk Road ("the A5006"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Stoke on Trent in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5006 Trunk Road (Stoke on Trent, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 29th October 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the trunk road" means the eastbound carriageway of the A5006 from its

roundabout junction with Campbell Road (Michelin Roundabout) to its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout Junction with the A50 and the slip roads leading to and from the A500 (Sideway Roundabout);

"the works period" means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 5th

November 2012 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (iii) being used for or in connection with the said works.
