**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A160 Trunk Road (Ulceby Road to Habrough Road Roundabout)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *1st November 2012*

*Coming into force* - - *8th November 2012*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A160 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the County of North Lincolnshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A160 Trunk Road (Ulceby Road to Habrough Road Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 8th November 2012.

**2.** In this Order; -

“the A160” means the A160 Trunk Road from its junction with the A1077 Ulceby Road to its junction with Habrough Road Roundabout, a distance of 870 metres;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 9th November 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A160.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A160 Trunk Road at its junctions with Ulceby Road.

**5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission, of a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
