ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A449 Trunk Road (Gailey to Four Ashes, Staffordshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 19th November 2012

Coming into force - - 26th November 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A449 Trunk Road (“the A449”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between Gailey and Four Ashes in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A449 Trunk Road (Gailey to Four Ashes, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 26th November 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A449 from its roundabout junction with the A5 at Gailey to its junction with Station Drive at Four Ashes;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 3rd December 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road.

4. The provisions of articles 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1

(c) being used in connection with the said works.
