**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A1 Trunk Road (Grantham, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - - *3rd December 2012*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *10th December 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads, at Grantham in the County of Lincolnshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Grantham, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 10th December 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to and from the A607 (Harlaxton Road) including the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout at its junction with Swingbridge Road;

“the central reservation” means that part of the A1 which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using that road;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 17th December 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to make a U-turn through the gap in the central reservation opposite Dallygate and Heath Lane at Great Ponton.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and

b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
