ROAD TRAFFIC

The M27 Motorway (Junctions 7 and 8, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - *17th December 2012*
Coming into force - - *26th January 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M27 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M27 Motorway (Junctions 7 and 8, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 26th January 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M27 Motorway near Southampton in the County of Hampshire;

“a slip road” means –

- (a) the road leading from the westbound carriageway of the motorway to the A334 at Junction 7, or
- (b) the road leading to the westbound carriageway of the motorway from the A3024 at Junction 8;

“works” mean carriageway repairs and all associated work on the motorway; and

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 28th January 2013 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 22:30 hours on Friday 1st February 2013 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 22:00 hours on Saturday 2nd February 2013 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iv) 7 hours starting at 22:30 hours on Sunday 3rd February 2013 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 25th July 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
