**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A52 and A5111 Trunk Roads (Derby) (Temporary  
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *29th October 2012*

*Coming into force* - - *5th November 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road (“the A52”), the A5111 Trunk Road (“A5111”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of the A52 and two of those connecting roads in the City of Derby should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 and A5111 Trunk Roads (Derby) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 5th November 2012.

2. In this Order

“the trunk road” means the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to the A5111 and Spondon Interchange to its junction with the entry slip road leading from Stoney Lane;

“the link road” means the link road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from the northbound carriageway of the A5111 (Raynesway);

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from its roundabout junction A6005/Derby Road;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 12th November 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road, the link road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
