**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A45 Trunk Road (Thurlaston Roundabout, Warwickshire)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *30th January 2012*  
*Coming into force* - - *6th February 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, near Thurlaston, in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Thurlaston Roundabout, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 6th February 2012.

2. In this Order:

| “the works period” | means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 13th February 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed,  |
| “ layby”           | means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right; |
| “the roundabout”   | means the circulatory carriageway of the A45 at its roundabout junction with the B4429 at Thurlaston, south west of Rugby;   |

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and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter the B4429 from its junction with the Roundabout.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby north west of the roundabout.

**5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

**6.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
