ROAD TRAFFIC

The A19 Trunk Road (Seaton Burn Interchange) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012

Made - - - - *3rd January 2012*

Coming into force - - *8th January 2012*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A19 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of North Tyneside, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road and one of those connecting roads should be restricted because sign replacement works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A19 Trunk Road (Seaton Burn Interchange) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 8th January 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 9th January 2012 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the A19 Trunk Road northbound carriageway from its junction with the B1318 Seaton Burn Roundabout to and including the A1 Trunk Road southbound entry slip road at Seaton Burn Interchange, a distance of 1010 metres.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.

4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
