**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A38 Trunk Road (Clay Mills to South of Findern)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - 24th February 2012

*Coming into force* - - - 2nd March 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Clay Mills in the County of Staffordshire and Findern in the County of Derbyshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Clay Mills to South of Findern) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 2nd March 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to the A5121 Derby Road, to its junction with the entry slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A50 and Etwall Road (Toyota Interchange);

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Friday 9th March 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of articles 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or

(c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
