ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A21 Trunk Road (Middle Lodge Roundabout, Near
Pembury) (Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction)
Order 2012**

Made - - - - *19th March 2012*

Coming into force - - *7th April 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A21 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A21 Trunk Road (Middle Lodge Roundabout, Near Pembury) (Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 7th April 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A21 Trunk Road near Pembury in the County of Kent;

“the length of carriageway” means the northbound carriageway of the trunk road between a point 250 metres south of Middle Lodge roundabout (Longfield Road) and that roundabout;

“works” mean carriageway repairs, road marking and road stud replacement work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Tuesday 10th April 2012 or on any subsequent day until 6th October 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
