ROAD TRAFFIC

The A57 Trunk Road (Jollies Corner) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

 Made
 6th March 2013

 Coming into force
 17th March 2013

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A57 Trunk Road, in the District of Tameside, in the County of Greater Manchester, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted and prohibited because carriageway repair works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A57 Trunk Road (Jollies Corner) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 17th March 2013.
- 2. In this Order; –

"the A57" means the A57 Trunk Road eastbound and westbound carriageways between the centreline of its junction with Shaw Street and the centreline of its junction with John Kennedy Road, a distance of 388 metres;

"the works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 18th March 2013 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the A57 at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on those carriageways are displayed.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A57 Trunk Road at its junction with the B6174 Stalybridge Road and the B6174 Market Street.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing in article 4 shall apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to any vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this article;

and nothing in article 4 shall apply to any vehicle proceeding in the A57 Trunk Road to or from premises and property which is accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.

6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
