**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Manston Airport)
Regulations 2013**

Made - - - - *30th April 2013*
Coming into force - - - *22nd June 2013*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Manston Airport, Kent by reason of the holding of a flying display that is scheduled to take place there on 22nd June 2013.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Manston Airport) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 22nd June 2013.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) between 1200 hours and 1700 hours on 22nd June 2013 no aircraft is to fly below 5,000 feet above mean sea level within the area of a circle having a radius of 3 nautical miles whose centre is at 512033N 0012046E.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with a clearance and any instructions issued by the air traffic control unit at Manston Airport.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Manston Airport, Kent, on the occasion of an air show that will be held there on 22nd June 2013. A large number of civil and military aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the event. The Civil Aviation Authority's Safety Regulation Group and Directorate of Airspace Policy, with the agreement of the Department for Transport, consider that flying should be restricted during the air show in the vicinity of Manston Airport for reasons of public safety.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by NOTAM.
