ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 9, Letchworth Gate, Hertfordshire) Southbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 21st January 2013

Coming into force - - 31st January 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 9, Letchworth Gate, Hertfordshire) Southbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 31st January 2013.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during the period starting at 06:00 hours on Thursday 31st January 2013 and ending when the likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this Order, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the entry slip road to the southbound carriageway of the A1(M) Motorway at Junction 9 Letchworth Gate.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for or in connection with any works to the slip road, or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes.
