ROAD TRAFFIC

The A405 Trunk Road (North Orbital Road, Northbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - - *2nd April 2013*

Coming into force - - - - - *20th April 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A405 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A405 Trunk Road (North Orbital Road, Northbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 20th April 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A405 Trunk Road in the County of Hertfordshire;

“the length of northbound carriageway” means the northbound carriageway of the trunk road between its junction with Chequers Lane (near M1 Junction 6) and its junction with the M25 Junction 21a roundabout near Bricket Wood;

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing, concrete bay repair, bridge joint replacement, road marking, stud reinstatement and all associated work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 22nd April 2013 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 26th April 2013 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 27th April 2013 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iii) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 28th April 2013 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 19th October 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of northbound carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
