ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A63 Trunk Road (South Cave Interchange) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - - *15th January 2013*

Coming into force - - - - - *20th January 2013*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A63 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the East Riding of Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road and one of those connecting roads should be restricted and prohibited because safety barrier renewal works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A63 Trunk Road (South Cave Interchange) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 20th January 2013.

2. In this Order;

“the A63” means the A63 Trunk Road;

“the first length of carriageway” means the A63 westbound carriageway from a point 2500 metres east of the centreline of the A1034 overbridge at South Cave Interchange westwards for a distance of 2700 metres;

“the second length of carriageway” means the A63 westbound carriageway from the nose of the westbound exit slip road at South Cave Interchange westwards for a distance of 500 metres;

“the slip road” means the A63 Trunk Road westbound entry slip road at South Cave Interchange;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 21st January 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the first length of carriageway.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of carriageway or the slip road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing in article 4 shall apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used for the purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this article.

6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
