**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal International
Air Tattoo RAF Fairford) (Amendment) Regulations 2013**

Made - - - - *21st May 2013*

Coming into force - - *17th July 2013*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of RAF Fairford, Gloucestershire by reason of the holding of flying displays that are scheduled to take place during the period from 17th to 22nd July 2013.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009^(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal International Air Tattoo RAF Fairford) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 17th July 2013.

Amendment of Regulations

2.—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal International Air Tattoo RAF Fairford) Regulations 2013^(b) are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 3(1), omit the words “at or above Flight Level 65 but”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Royal Air Tattoo RAF Fairford) Regulations 2013 (S.I. 2013/932) by amending the height restriction in relation to the area mentioned in regulation 3(1) of those Regulations. The restriction now applies to all the airspace below Flight Level 85 within that area.

Full details of the restricted airspace will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
