**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Chandler's Cross)
Regulations 2013**

Made - - - - - *23rd May 2013*

Coming into force - - - - - *5th June 2013*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Chandler's Cross, Hertfordshire, by reason of the holding of the Bilderberg Conference that is scheduled to take place there between 5th and 9th June 2013.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Chandler's Cross) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 5th June 2013.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 1300 hours on 5th June and 1300 hours on 9th June 2013, no aircraft is to fly below 2,500 feet above mean sea level within the area of a circle having a radius of 1 nautical mile whose centre is 514042N 0002611W.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft—

- (a) flying in the service of—
 - (i) the National Police Air Service,
 - (ii) the Metropolitan Police Service, or
 - (iii) the Helicopter Emergency Medical Service; or
- (b) being operated with the permission of Chief Inspector Dave Rhodes of the Hertfordshire Police.

(a) S.I. 2009/3015, to which there are amendments that are not relevant to these Regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations restrict flying in the vicinity of Chandler's Cross, Hertfordshire, during the Bilderberg Conference, which is scheduled to take place there between 5th and 9th June 2013. The Hertfordshire Police has requested these restrictions, which form part of the overall security arrangements for this event. This request has been agreed with the Civil Aviation Authority's Directorate of Airspace Policy (DAP) and the Department for Transport.

Full details of the airspace restrictions will be promulgated by NOTAM.
