**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A43 Trunk Road (Brackley to Evenley, Northamptonshire)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - 22nd July 2013  
*Coming into force* - - 29th July 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A43 Trunk Road (“the A43”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, between Brackley and Evenley in the County of Northamptonshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A43 Trunk Road (Brackley to Evenley, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 29th July 2013.

2. In this Order –

“Buckingham Road Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A43 with the A422 and Buckingham Road, east of Brackley;

“Evenley Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A43 with Broad Lane, near Evenley;

“Oxford Road Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A43 with the A422 and Oxford Road, south of Brackley;

“the trunk road” means –  
i) the northbound carriageway of the A43 from Evenley Roundabout to Buckingham Road Roundabout; and

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- ii) the southbound carriageway of the A43 from Buckingham Road Roundabout to Evenley Roundabout including Oxford Road Roundabout;

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 **(a)** and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 5th August 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby situated adjacent to the trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave Oxford Road Roundabout at its junction with –

- i) the A422;
- ii) Oxford Road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
