**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A49 Trunk Road (Leebotwood to Dorrington, Shropshire)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *26th July 2013*  
*Coming into force* - - *2nd August 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road (“the A49”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Leebotwood and Dorrington, south of Shrewsbury in the County of Shropshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Leebotwood to Dorrington, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 2nd August 2013.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A49 from its junction with the B4370 south of Leebotwood to its junction with Falkland Road, south of Dorrington;

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Thursday 8th August 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

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and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby adjacent to the trunk road –

- i) approximately 985 metres north of Station Road at Leebotwood; and
- ii) approximately 1075 metres north of Station Road at Leebotwood.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave any side road at its junction with the trunk road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of -

(1) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works ; and

(2) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
