**The A46 Trunk Road (Wanlip to Anstey) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - 2nd August 2013

Coming into force - - 9th August 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and three of those connecting roads, between Wanlip and Anstey in the County of Leicestershire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Wanlip to Anstey) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 9th August 2013.

2. In this Order –

“the first length of trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A46 from a point 1600 metres northeast of the centreline of the eastern overbridge of the roundabout junction of the A46 and A6 at Wanlip for a distance of 1600 metres in a south westerly direction;

“the second length of trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout junction with the A6 at Wanlip to its junction with the slip road leading from the roundabout junction with the A5630, Leicester Road and Gynsill Lane at Anstey;

“the first slip road” means the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A46 to the roundabout junction with the A6 at Wanlip;

“the second slip road” means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A46 from the roundabout junction with the A6 at Wanlip;

“the third slip road” means the slip road leading from the southbound

carriageway of the A46 to the roundabout junction with the A5630, Leicester Road and Gynsill Lane at Anstey:

“layby”

means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 16th August 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk or the first slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of trunk road, the second slip road or the third slip road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby situated adjacent to the second length of trunk road.

6. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of –

- a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
- b) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- c) articles 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
