ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A46 Trunk Road (Syston) (Temporary Restriction and
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

<i>Made</i>	- - - -	<i>5th August 2013</i>
<i>Coming into force</i>	- -	<i>12th August 2013</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads, at Syston in the County of Leicestershire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Syston) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 12th August 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A46 from a point 100 metres north of its roundabout junction with the A607 (Hobby Horse Roundabout) to a point 400 metres north of its junction with the exit slip road leading to Syston Road roundabout south east of Cossington;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A46 to the roundabout junction with Syston Road south east of Cossington;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Sunday 18th August 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

5. The provisions of article 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

(a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;

(b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and

(c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
