ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A46 Trunk Road (Groby, Leicestershire) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - *16th August 2013*
Coming into force - - *23rd August 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those connecting roads near Groby, in the County of Leicestershire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Groby, Leicestershire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 23rd August 2013.

2. In this Order –

| “a slip road” | means any slip road leading to or from the A46 at its roundabout junction with the A50 Markfield Road and the A50 Groby Road; |
| “overall width” | has the same meaning given in regulation 3(2) of the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986(b); |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Tuesday 27th August 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed; |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on a slip road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle with an overall width exceeding 3 metres to enter or proceed on a slip road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of –

- a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
- b) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- c) articles 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
