**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M66 Motorway Junction 4 (M60 / M62 Junction 18  
Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *10th September 2013*

*Coming into force* - - *16th September 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M66 Motorway, is satisfied that traffic on sections of that motorway in the Borough of Bury in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the M66 Motorway Junction 4 (M60/M62 Junction 18 Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 16th September 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M66 Motorway;

“the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road” means the last point where the slip road leaves the carriageway of the motorway or trunk road;

“the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road” means the first point where the slip road joins the carriageway of the motorway or trunk road;

“the length of carriageway” means the northbound carriageway of the motorway from the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 4 to the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 4;

“the works period” means periods overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 (continuing to 0700 hours on Saturday and Sunday mornings) hours during a period starting on Tuesday 17 September 2013 and ending on Monday 21 October 2013. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such further period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“Works” means resurfacing, road markings, road stud works and general maintenance works on the motorway.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or by traffic officers, or for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
