ROAD TRAFFIC

The A303 Trunk Road (Stonehenge Right Turn Ban) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 25th September 2013

Coming into force - - 28th September 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A303 Trunk Road (“the A303”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Stonehenge in Wiltshire should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public from traffic attempting to turn right from the A303:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A303 Trunk Road (Stonehenge Right Turn Ban) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 28th September 2013.

2. In this Order -

“the A303” means the A303 between its closed junction with the A344 at Stonehenge Bottom and its junction with the A360 at Longbarrow Roundabout;

“the period of danger” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Tuesday 1st October 2013 and ending when the likelihood of danger has ended;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the period of danger, cause or permit any vehicle proceeding westwards on the A303 to turn right into Byway 12.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
