ROAD TRAFFIC

The A404 Trunk Road (Burchett's Green Junction – Handy Cross Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - - *7th October 2013*

Coming into force - - - - - *26th October 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A404 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of that road and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A404 Trunk Road (Burchett's Green Junction - Handy Cross Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 26th October 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A404 Trunk Road in the Royal Borough of Windsor & Maidenhead and the County of Buckinghamshire;

"the length of trunk road" means both carriageways of the trunk road between Burchett's Green Junction (A4130) and Handy Cross Interchange (M40 Junction 4/A4010);

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b);

“an A404 lay-by” means the lay-bys in the length of trunk road;

“a slip road” means any road leading to the northbound carriageway or the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Handy Cross Interchange (M40 Junction 4/A4010), Marlow Interchange (A4155) and Burchett's Green Junction (A4130);

“a side road” means any road leading to the length of trunk road;

“works” mean resurfacing, road marking, stud reinstatement and all associated works on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 28th October 2013 or on any subsequent day until 25th April 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit –

- (a) any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road, a side road or a slip road, or
- (b) any vehicle to enter or proceed in, or wait on, an A404 lay-by.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
