ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A6 Trunk Road (Alvaston, Derby) (Temporary Restriction
and Prohibition of Traffic) (No. 2) Order 2013**

Made - - - - 4th October 2013

Coming into force - - 11th October 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A6 Trunk Road (“the A6”) is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, in the City of Derby and the County of Derbyshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A6 Trunk Road (Alvaston, Derby) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (No. 2) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 11th October 2013.
2. In this Order:

“the trunk road”	means – (i) northbound carriageway of the A6 from and its roundabout junction with the B5010 and Shardlow Road, to its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A5111 (Raynesway); and (ii) southbound carriageway of the A6 from its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A5111 (Raynesway) to its roundabout junction with the B5010 and Shardlow Road;

“a horse”	includes a horse, pony, ass or mule;

“the works period”	means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Saturday 12th October 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the trunk road.

- 4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no –
- (i) pedestrian, or person using a pedal cycle with four wheels or fewer and not being a mechanically propelled vehicle, shall enter or proceed,
 - (ii) person shall ride upon a horse, or
 - (iii) person shall cause or permit any cart or carriage which is drawn by a horse to enter or proceed,
- in the footpath/cycleway leading from Bridlegate Lane to Elvaston Lane.
- 5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 6.** The provisions of:
- (a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (iii) being used for special forces purposes; and
 - (b) article 4 shall not apply to –
 - (i) any pedestrian engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activities;
 - (ii) any pedestrian acting under the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (iii) personnel engaged in the said works.
