ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road and the M6 Toll Motorway (Mile Oak to Shenstone, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - *14th October 2013*
Coming into force - - *21st October 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), M6 Toll Motorway (“the M6 Toll”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that trunk road and some of those connecting roads, in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road and the M6 Toll Motorway (Mile Oak To Shenstone, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 21st October 2013.

2. In this Order:

| “Shenstone Interchange” | means the A5/A5148/A5127/M6 Toll interchange; |
| “the trunk road” | means –
(a) the westbound carriageway of the A5 from its junction with the slip road leading to its junction with the A453 Bonehill Road, at Mile Oak, to its junction with the slip road leading from Shenstone Interchange; and
(b) the eastbound carriageway of the A5 from its roundabout junction with the A5148 and A5127 at Shenstone Interchange to its junction with the slip road leading from roundabout junction at Mile Oak; |
| “a slip road” | means –
(a) any slip road leading to or from the trunk road; and
(b) the slip roads leading to and from the M6 Toll to and from the roundabout junction of the A38 and A5 (Weeford Roundabout); |

“the works period”

means the period starting at 19.00 hours on Monday 28th October 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave any side road at its junction with the trunk road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
