ROAD TRAFFIC

The A259 Trunk Road (Straight Lane, Brenzett) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2013

Made - - - - *4th November 2013*

Coming into force - - *23rd November 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Straight Lane, Brenzett) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 23rd November 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A259 Trunk Road in the County of Kent;

“the length of trunk road” means the trunk road between a point 285 metres west of railway crossing and Brenzett roundabout (A2070/B2080);

“works” mean resurfacing, inlays carriageway remarking, reinstallation of studs, related highways and any other essential carriageway repair work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 25th November 2013 or on any subsequent day until 22nd May 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

(a) 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road, while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed; or

(b) 40 miles per hour on the length of trunk road, while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to that length of road are not displayed.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and
